




Congratulations on your new Sivo Edge! Use this guide for quick access to information on use and care. Refer to your full user manuals for more detailed information!

Long Term Storage

- Charge the battery system to 80%
- Turn the “Tow/Run” switch to the “Tow” position.
- Remove the key and keep it in a safe place.
- Ensure each tire is inflated to 25psi.
- Ensure battery cable connections are secure and free of corrosion
- Clean the body, seats, battery box, and chassis.
- If storing outdoors, cover the vehicle with a storage cover.
- Monitor the battery connections charge state and cables for corrosion monthly.
- Press and hold battery power button for 5 seconds to turn off.

Safe Operation Instructions

Please make sure to observe the following safe operation instructions. Ensure you are familiar with all of the controls of the vehicle prior to operating. Prior to operating the vehicle, perform checks on the battery, tires, body/chassis, brakes, parking brake, and steering. To power on your Sivo Edge, first ensure the battery is powered on and the **RUN/OFF/EMB** switch is in the “run” position. Next, press the button with the “Unlock” symbol on your vehicle's key fob. The lights on your Edge will flash once to confirm. You can now power the vehicle on by pressing the power button on the dashboard.



1. Multifunction switch (Headlights, High beams, Turn signals, Horn)
2. Steering column adjustment lock
3. Glove box lighting
4. Emergency flashers
5. Charging and power ports
6. Power button
7. F/R shift switch
8. Fan control switch
9. Front storage latch
10. Brake and Accelerator pedals
11. RUN/OFF/EMB switch
12. Battery power button
13. Brake fluid reservoir
14. Charging port

Remember to press the button with the “Unlock” symbol on your vehicle's key fob. Once pressed, the lights on your Edge will flash once to confirm. You can now power the vehicle on by pressing the power button on the dashboard. Press the power button again to turn your cart off.

If your cart is not used for a period of time, the battery may power off to conserve state of charge. The power button on your battery is located on the side of the battery case. If the green ring in the button is illuminated, the battery is on. Press once to turn on, press and hold to turn off.
